What do we really think of authority?

Romans 13:1 Authority = A Good Thing

Passage – Ephesians 6:1 – 3 "Honor Your Father and Mother"

Background: 10 Commandments, Exodus 20:12 plus Colossians 3:20

How big of a deal is this?

Leviticus 20:9, Deuteronomy 21:18 - 21, Romans 1:28 - 31 Big Deal!

What does it mean to "honor?"

Basic – respect; Hebrew – weighty, glorious, burdensome, significant priority; Greek – prize, value, revere

We can honor our parents when we keep in mind several notions.

•Obedience - big one, used hand in hand in scripture

Simple – do what they say

Action, evidence of honoring, understanding consequences

*Exception – anything that is contrary to God's law/will

- •Attitude humble, patient, gentleness, kindness, goodness, self-control Ephesians 4:2-3
- Perception
 - life stages
 - parents are not perfect
 - "position" of parent
 - communication
- •Forgiveness Colossians 3:13
