Intro – Glad to be here, other comments

Read entire passage of 3 John

Impersonations (imitations)

*Who do we or should we imitate?

Paul in 1 Cor. 11:1 says, "Imitate me as I imitate Christ." Consider that question as we look at 3 John

The book of 3 John

The "elder" = John the Apostle (this is widely accepted)
Personal letter
Comment on typical greeting/closing
Relates to 2 John – a letter to a church/congregation
*Major themes of John books – Love and Truth (walking in the truth, walking in love)
See 1 John 4:7&8 – Let us *love* one another

3 John 4 – No greater joy for John when people walk in truth

Background on what's going on – the Gospel is being spread by itinerant missionaries/evangelists

They need support in their work – lodging, food, encouragement, etc

Compare 2 John to 3 John – itinerant teachers with "bad" doctrine should not be supported

The letter's recipient (Gauis) is doing good with this missionaries and John commends him

The 3 people mentioned in 3 John

Gauis – faithful to the truth; walking in the truth Loving – hospitable (kind, compassionate)

Diotrephes – loves to be first

<u>not</u> hospitable

spreads nonsense (gossip)

(domineering)

Demetrius – not much known about well-spoken of

Verse 11 – imitate what is good, not what is evil

*We should imitate Gauis and Demetrius, not Diotrephes

Note - For us today we need to not get distracted with the historical/cultural particulars (being hospitable to itinerant missionaries) but understand the spiritual principal John is indicating: walk in the truth and live it out in love (and obedience).

Bottom Line: *Imitate those who live out the truth in love – be like them, follow their example.
