Background (Set-Up)

- Paul persecuted Christians, conversion, planted churches, wrote much of NT, pillar of the faith
- Writing from prison, knew his life would end soon
- Timothy good friend, protégé (mentoree)

Passage: 2 Timothy 4:6 & 7

Poured out; drink offering Time for departure is near "...good fight, finished race, kept the faith."

The heart of the matter: Paul encourages us to end well Illustrates with running a race

*Paul encourages us to end well, as he has...And we can when we remember Paul's reminders

Passage: 2 Timothy 3:10 - 13

Timothy knows everything that Paul has been through Paul has finished well anyway

Reminder: Persecution Will Come

Helps us anticipate suffering and hardship Helps us press on thru the persecution

Passage: 2 Timothy 3:14 – 17 Continue (keep going) because of what you know You (Timothy) know me (Paul) You know scripture (God's truth)

Reminder: You Know What is Right and True

Don't be misled Truth is not relative

Passage: 2 Timothy 4:1 – 5 Timothy: Preach the Word (as an evangelist) For all Believers: love God, love neighbor, obey, repent, worship, pray, etc.)

Reminder: Do What You Were Meant to Do

If you don't know, find out what God might have you to do (like preach for Timothy) Comment on Sound Doctrine vs. Itching Ears

If you're going to run a race, RACE. If you're going to be a Jesus follower, BE a Jesus follower.

Ask: Why would we want to end well?

Passage: 2 Timothy 4:8 A crown of righteousness – from the race illustration (laurel wreath)

We can finish well.
