QUESTIONS TO PONDER—What did you find that was new, interesting, confusing, convicting in your reading this week?

- 1. Sunday, June 11; Romans 10:1-9; Declare and Believe Jesus to be Saved. Read passage with notes. What was Paul's heart's desire and prayer (1)? What was the problem for the Jews in a nutshell (2-3)? What were they missing (4)? Why was the law too difficult (5, Lev. 18:5)? Why is faith easier (6-8)? What are the three elements of salvation (9)? Personal Application: How is the Word near you and in your mouth (8)? When did you declare and believe Jesus to be saved (10?)
- 2. Monday, June 12; Romans 10:10-15; Send Missionaries to Tell Good News—Beautiful Feet. Read passage with notes. How is salvation both inward and outward (10)? Who will never be put to shame (11)? Read Is. 28:16. Who is the Cornerstone of your faith or mine? Why does FAITH now unite the two groups—Jews and Gentiles (12-13)? What important consideration does Paul bring up (14-15)? Personal Application: What elements are necessary for the Gospel message to be preached (14-15)? In what ways do you or I possess "beautiful feet"? To whom do you preach the gospel just by living it?
- **3. Tuesday, June 13; Romans 10:16-21; Gentiles Accepted, Jews Rejected**. Read passage and notes. In verses 16-20 find the verbs that are necessary to an active relationship with God/Jesus Christ. What was Israel's stumbling block in verse 16? 17-18? 19? Why did God turn to the Gentiles (20-21)? Personal Application: What role does disobedience or obstinance play in your life or mine? How do you or I accept, believe, hear understand, and find God for ourselves?
- **4. Wednesday, June 14; Romans 11:1-6; Remnant**. Read passage with notes. In a nutshell, what is the answer to the question "Did God reject the Israelites?" Why was Elijah all for God rejecting the Jews (3)? What did God say (4)? Why is a remnant of Jewish believers important (5)? Why does grace trump works (6)? **Personal Application**: Just like Elijah, how does your frustration or mine with the condition of the world stand in the way of God's grace? How may you or I be God's tool of grace?
- **5.** Thursday, June 15; Romans 11:7-12; Jews Who Reject May Also Return. Read passage and notes. What is the truth about the people of Israel (7-8)? What was David's wish for his non-believing nation (9-10)? How was Israel's transgression used for good (11-12a)? What is the awesome hope for the nation of Israel (12b)? **Personal Application**: What lesson do you or I take to heart regarding the nation of Israel and their rejection or faith in God?
- **6. Friday, June 16; Romans 11:13-24; Grafted In.** Read passage with notes. Why is Paul excited to be working with the Gentiles and what is his hope for the Jews (13-16)? What warning does Paul give to the Gentiles about becoming a part of God's family when the Jews are not (17-18)? Why are the Gentiles warned to remain humble (19-21)? How has God been kind to you or me and how do we "continue in His kindness" (22)? What does our long-suffering God hope the Jews will do (23-24)? **Personal Application**: Why is being "grafted in" a miracle? How are you or I thankful to accept the amazing gift of being grafted in to God's family?
- **7. Saturday, June 17; Romans 11:25-36; God is Merciful to All, Who Can Fathom It**? Read passage with notes. When will Israel return to the Lord (25)? How will God thus remain true to His covenant with Israel (26-27, Isaiah 59:20,21; 27:9 and Jer. 31:33-34)? How does human disobedience give special light to our merciful God (28-32)? How is it truly overwhelming to think of God's plan for humanity (33-36, Isaiah 40:13 and Job 41:11)? **Personal Application**: Worship God through reading and reflecting on verses 33-36.
